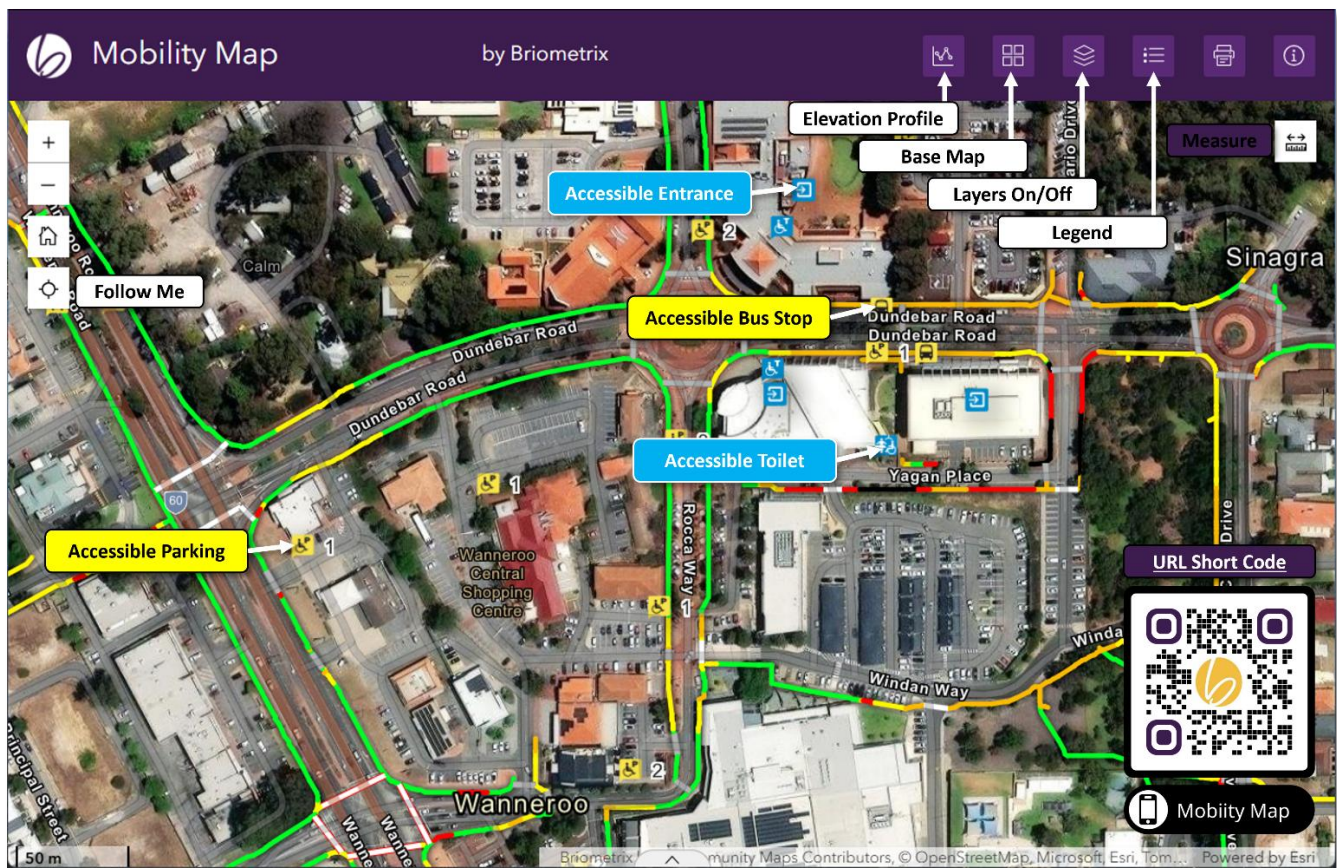

EFFORT RATING AND STREET CROSSINGS

Effort Ratings show how easy or difficult a pathway may be to travel.

Ratings are based on:

- slope
- crossfall
- surface type and condition

Difficulty may vary depending on individual mobility needs and equipment.

Crossings are shown to help identify safer route options.

Marked Crossings - Traffic-light crossings or zebra crossings.

Caution Crossings - A red outline indicates a more difficult or hazardous kerb ramp.

Some crossings may not be shown if they were assessed as unsuitable for wheelchair access.

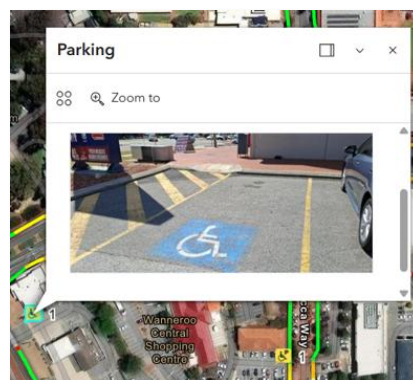
